ANIMAL CONTROL  
BYLAW 5/2015

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR RESTRICTIONS ON KEEPING OF  
ANIMALS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF  
LOON LAKE**

The Council of the Village of Loon Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

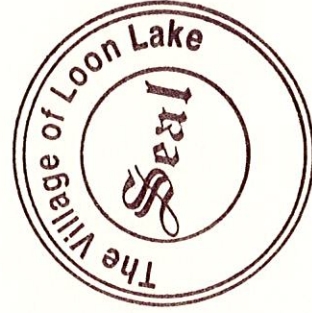
**I. DEFINITIONS**


1. **LIVESTOCK** shall mean any animal belonging to a species of animal, other than canine or feline, that is usually raised in captivity for the purpose of the production of offspring, the production of animal products as defined by *The Animal Products Act*, or for the commercial sale of the animal or any part of it whether it is edible or inedible including fertilized ova, fish and bees; whether or not that animal is actually being raised in captivity for any of those purpose.
2. **POULTRY** shall mean any bird raised in captivity for the purpose of:
  - a. Any domestic fowl such as chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, pigeons
  - b. The production of any animal products as defined by *The Animal Products Act*; or
  - c. Commercial resale of the bird or any part of it whether edible or inedible, any by-product of the bird including fertilized or unfertilized ova.
3. **R – Residential Zoning District** means a zoning district established by the Village of Loon Lake bylaw.
4. **C- Commercial Zoning District** means a zoning district established by the Village of Loon Lake bylaw.
5. **PET** means any animal as defined by the *Animal Protection Act, 2010*.


**II. REGULATIONS**

1. No person(s) may possess or house more than five pets per household.
2. No person(s) shall be permitted to possess livestock, horses or poultry within the limits of the Village of Loon Lake.
3. No exotic pets such as boa constrictors, pythons, venomous snakes, spiders, crocodiles, scorpions, bees or animals that may create a health hazard as defined by *The Public Health Act*, shall be permitted within the limits of the Village of Loon Lake.
4. Any person convicted of a breach of provisions of this Bylaw shall be subject to the penalty set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Loon Lake and amendments thereto.
5. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of its final reading.
