Media Release - Property Crime Arrest

On December 1st, Loon Lake RCMP responded to the Ministikwan resort area for a complaint of a suspicious truck. Prior to RCMP arrival, the suspects fled the area after being confronted by local residents. Several stolen items were recovered inside the truck. With the assistance of the RCMP Police Dog Team, a suspect was located hiding under a deck near the scene. 33 year old Louis Mitsuing was taken into custody and has been charged with Mischief under \$5000, Possession of Stolen Property, and Theft. Mitsuing has been remanded and will appear in Meadow Lake Provincial Court on Monday December 3rd. This investigation is ongoing.

As an update to the previous release regarding the outstanding warrant for Matthew Belly, Edmonton Police Service was investigating a stolen vehicle in their jurisdiction and came across Matthew Belly. He was taken into custody and has been charged with resisting arrest and numerous breaches of his existing conditions order. He remains in custody in Alberta.
